



Mathematics Teaching Internship

Windsor Upper School is a grades 6-12 coeducational day school located in Nassau, the Bahamas at Albany. We are currently looking to hire a full-time Math teaching intern to join our community. Energetic and adventurous teachers who want to shape all aspects of our seven-year progression are encouraged to apply.

Windsor School is a coeducational day and (small) boarding school. On our Albany campus we serve approximately 250 students in grades 6–12 from 37 countries, with a majority of our students local to the Bahamas; twenty percent of our student body annually earn athletic and academic college scholarships. In addition to our core classes, which include Business in the high school, Windsor offers a Golf Academy and signature programs in Marine Biology (Blue Ocean), Entrepreneurship, and Performing Arts.

Interest in teaching all levels of mathematics, especially AP Statistics and AP Calculus AB/BC; experience with independent schools, Khan Academy, and Singapore Math; and a strong desire to teach a mastery-based curriculum are preferred. The internship program revolves around shadowing three sections of math with gradually increasing duties in one section to full time teaching and instructing by the end of the first term. Observing other disciplines and aiding with substitute teaching responsibilities, and aiding with all the duties of maintaining a campus that includes middle schoolers will round out day-to-day activities.
