

Science/STEM Instructor

Windsor Upper School is a grades 6-12 coeducational day school located in Nassau, the Bahamas at Albany. We are currently looking to hire a full-time science teacher to join our community. Energetic and adventurous teachers who want to shape all aspects of our seven-year progression are encouraged to apply.

The ideal candidate should demonstrate willingness to teach all levels and types of science as well as an interest in continuing to shape a middle school curriculum that feeds traditional high school courses in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics. Curiosity around understanding and implementing Bahamian standards at the BJC and BGCSE levels is welcome. An interest in STEM, Physics, or AP Psychology would be a plus.

Windsor School is a coeducational day and (small) boarding school. On our Albany campus we serve approximately 250 students in grades 6–12 from 37 countries, with a majority of our students local to the Bahamas; twenty percent of our student body annually earn athletic and academic college scholarships. In addition to our core classes, which include Business in the high school, Windsor offers a Golf Academy and signature programs in Marine Biology (Blue Ocean), Entrepreneurship, and Performing Arts
