Windsor Upper School is a grades 6-12 coeducational day school located in Nassau, the Bahamas at Albany. We are currently looking to hire a full-time Humanities teacher who can teach History and English in the middle and upper school. On our Albany campus we serve approximately 250 students in grades 6–12 from 37 countries, with a majority of our students local to the Bahamas; twenty percent of our student body annually earn athletic and academic college scholarships. In addition to our core classes, which include Business in the high school, Windsor offers a Golf Academy and signature programs in Marine Biology (Blue Ocean), Entrepreneurship, and Performing Arts.
